

Tahquamenon Falls Rules of the Water

- All persons must wear personal flotation devices.
- No person or persons shall operate a vessel while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Family boat max weight is 1,000 lbs.
- Boat Attendants will make the final call if your group exceeds the weight limit.
- This is a no contact lake; body contact with the water is prohibited. No swimming.
- You may not add additional people to the boat once you leave the dock.
- Do not stand or switch seats.
- Do not bump other boats.
- Swimming is not permitted in boating area.
- No diving, jumping off, or leaving the boat at any time when out on the open water.
- No glass is allowed on the boat at any time.
- Life jackets must be worn by all boat riders until the boat leaves the marina. All boat riders under the age of 12 must always have their life jackets on.
- Beaching boats is strictly prohibited.
- Always keep a three-boat length distance from other boats.
- Towing other boats is prohibited.
- Alcohol is not permitted anywhere on the water.
- Littering and/or disposal of trash in the water is strictly prohibited.
- Smoking or vaping is not permitted on the boats.
- We are not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged personal belongings.
- You are responsible for returning your boat. If you fail to return your boat undamaged you will be subject additional charges.
- If your boat is left on the island a \$10 fee will be applied to the card, or deposit will be forfeited.
